

OVERVIEW: Course Registration for 2010-2011: Grades 9-11

Feb. 18 th to 26 th :	Student logs in and views teacher recommendations for required courses and requests elective classes in the Infinite Campus Student Portal. Student also selects alternate course requests
Feb. 19 th to Mar 19 th :	Counselors meet with 9 th , 10 th , and 11 th grade students to review and finalize all course requests.

About the Central High School Schedule

Each student has been automatically assigned:

- One Lunch period
- One Wellness class (Physical Education and Health)
- Recommended classes. Teachers will recommend one course per academic area at the highest level the student is eligible to enroll in, although multiple options may exist. Teacher recommended courses will be listed in the student's course registration window under "Required courses". These may be adjusted when the student meets with his/her counselor.
- Students will enter requests for electives (requested courses). Students must request courses to complete a total of 9 periods (including Lunch, Wellness, and those classes recommended by the student's academic teachers) using the "Add course" feature. Clicking on the course name in the course registration window will open a description of the course which includes the grade level the course may be taken in and any prerequisites for the class. - Full year vs. Semester class: Some classes are full year (5 or more credits), some are semester (half year--2.5 credits). Students may select two semester classes to fill one period for the year.
- Study Hall: One period each semester may be a study hall, which may provide valuable benefit to a student for quiet study, time to meet with teachers or coaches, or time to access the Media Center or computer labs. Students selecting an advanced placement science must select a study hall to accommodate its extensive lab schedule.
- Senior Option: Rising seniors desiring an off-campus privilege called "Senior Option" (available if approved by the administration and the student's parent or legal guardian) must select a study hall.

Important notes:

If you think you should be eligible for a course that does not appear in your list of teacher recommended courses, this should first be discussed with your teacher. Your counselor cannot override a teacher recommendation for placement. You must speak to your teacher to see if the course you hope to request is an appropriate option for you. However, if you are recommended for an honors level or advanced placement course that you do not wish to take, this will be adjusted when you meet with your counselor to finalize your requests.

ALL requests are pending approval. Administrative approval of all course requests will be made after third quarter grades are reviewed. In addition, students who do not maintain the prerequisite FINAL grade average for entry into a course will be required to choose an alternative course.

Example: John has been assigned Lunch and Wellness 1. His teachers selected English 1 Honors, World History, Biology Honors, Geometry, and Spanish 3 for him. All of these classes add up to seven full class periods. John has room to add electives for two more full periods. He selects Concert Choir (full year class) and two semester electives, Computer Essentials and Inside Microsoft Office. This fills his schedule. He also chooses American Cuisine and Intro to TV Production as alternate class requests in case he does not get his first choice requests.

John does not want to take Biology Honors. When he meets with his high school counselor for program planning, he will ask to be placed in regular Biology. John **does** want to take World History Honors but was not recommended for it because he has not made the grade prerequisite by the end of second marking period. He will tell his current social studies teacher of his interest in World History Honors for grade 9 and work his hardest to earn the grade prerequisite for entry into honors by the end of third marking period.
