I HEREBY REQUEST THAT I BE CONSIDERED AS A CANDIDATE FOR THE FOLLOWING SCHOLARSHIPS:

_____ The **Bear Tavern PTO Scholarship** of \$500 each to (2) **two** graduating seniors who were **former students of Bear Tavern Elementary School** and who plan to further his/her academic studies at the college level. The scholarship is funded by the Bear Tavern Book Fair and is to be used to defray the cost of college textbooks.

_____ The **Mae K. Burd Memorial Scholarship** in the amount of \$500 to a graduating senior who intends to major in **teacher education** at a four year college or university.
